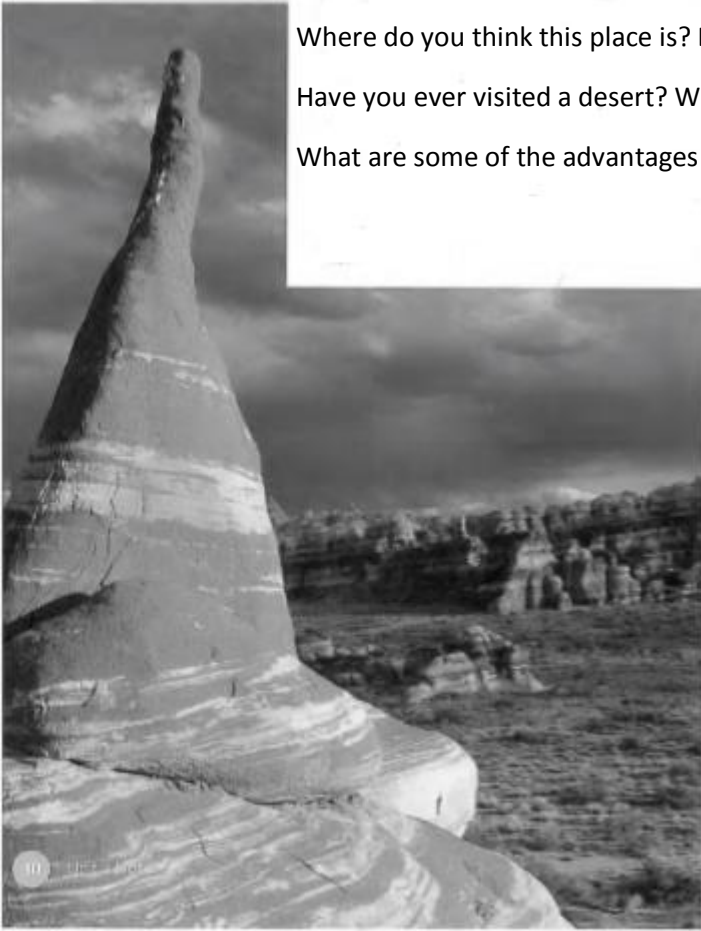


Look at the Picture and write about:
